Attached are the menus of meals being offered at Trinity Christian School during the school year 2011-2012. The suppliers with their corresponding days of food service are as follows:

1. Monday - Jim Bob's
2. Tuesday - Cici's Pizza
3. Wednesday -
4. Thursday - Chick-fil-A
5. Friday - Papa Joe's

Money will be collected each Friday for the next week's orders. If there is no school on a Friday, orders will be taken on Thursday. Ordering envelopes will be sent home with the children prior to Friday. Orders will be taken Friday August 19<sup>th</sup>, for food service beginning Monday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>. **Please be sure your child's name, grade, food ordered, and amount enclosed are on each envelope.** If you do not have an envelope for the correct restaurant, please do not scratch through another restaurant's envelope. The food vendors provide these envelopes at their own expense. If you do not have an envelope for the restaurant you need, use a blank one from home. All orders must be turned in during homeroom (7:50-8:00 AM) to be ready for pick-up by suppliers on Friday morning. **Orders will not be accepted after homeroom, so please prepare envelopes before arriving at school. (NO EXCEPTIONS)** Please note that the school office does not keep enough cash in the office to make change for the preparation of lunch envelopes. Please do this before arriving at school.

Money will be collected each Friday for the following week's Ice Cream orders. Please either pay by cash or check made payable to Trinity Christian School (TCS). Then on the outside of the envelope mark the appropriate day(s) and ice cream amount(s).

Milk and juice are \$.35 each. **The first week of school, milk and OJ may be paid for on a daily basis. After the first week of school, tokens must be purchased on a weekly basis in classrooms on Friday mornings for the following week. One token is valued at \$.35.** Milk tokens for the first week of school will be sold during homeroom on Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup>. Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup> tokens will be sold for the coming school week. Milk money will not be taken up daily. Only tokens will be accepted after the first week of school. Your children are welcome to bring beverages from home that can be kept in their lunch boxes. We do not provide refrigeration at the school for sack lunches or beverages for students. Please do not send carbonated beverages.
