

Blue Jean Day Guidelines

Jeans days will fall on the last school day Friday of each month. All K-12 students may participate in jeans day provided that they have paid their \$10.00 fee.

The following guidelines are provided along with points of clarification on issues that have come up in the past. Please remind your kids that it is the school's position that clothing is an outward expression of the heart. They should dress as students with a heart for the Lord.

- Uniform shorts with a belt may be worn on jeans day. Uniform skirts, and skorts are permitted for girls.
- T-shirts such as TCS fun run t-shirts or Auburn t-shirts may be worn instead of uniform shirts. (The definition of a t-shirt for our purposes is a cotton crew neck pullover shirt without buttons which may or may not have a logo, image, or verbiage screen printed on the front and/or back. This does not include athletic jerseys, polos, oxfords, henleys, blouses, church clothes, etc. Shirts promoting alcohol, rock bands, offensive images or phrases, and other content that is of a nature opposed to Christianity are not permitted. Please be sure that your girls are modest and that the t-shirts do not come up when they raise their hands and are not excessively tight.)
- Blue jeans (long pants) should be unadorned and without holes. (Unadorned means plain blue denim jeans with no patches, stickers, rhinestones, or writing across the backside. Please do not allow your kids to wear excessively tight jeans.)
- Shoe requirements are the same as any day at school.

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
