3. We understand that the teaching at Trinity Christian School will be consistent with the system of Biblical beliefs contained in the Westminster Confession of Faith.
4. We are in agreement with the discipline policy and give permission to administer such discipline as described, including corporal punishment if deemed necessary.
5. We agree to work toward the overall welfare, peace, and purity of Trinity Christian School.
6. We agree to handle grievances according to the grievance procedures.
7. We understand that the school will provide competent teachers, a full and balanced curriculum, regular reporting, supervision of the administrator and communication with the home. We further recognize that the school is not equipped to handle the educational needs of all children. Parents must submit copies of all previous tests and submit to additional testing if the need for such arises.
8. We agree to adhere to the dress code.
9. We agree to pay our tuition and fees when due. We realize that a \$5.00 per child late fee will be charged when tuition is received past the 10th of each month. If payment is not received by the 20th, suspension of the student will occur until the financial obligation is met.
10. We agree as a family to participate weekly in worship at a local church.
