We are excited about our upcoming 2011/12 basketball season. Please read the information below to determine whether your son will be interested in playing this year. If you have a question that is not answered, please do not hesitate to contact me personally.

Eligibility

Any boy from sixth through twelfth grades can participate. The varsity is normally grades nine through twelve while the junior varsity is normally grades six through nine. Who can play on the junior varsity will be determined in part by the league rules of our opponents.

Cost

The cost is \$125 per player. This includes uniforms, equipment, and travel costs. It does not include shoes. If your son played last year, he is welcome to wear those shoes. If he did not play or will get new shoes this year, please get white, black, or some combination of the two.

Many times, we will stop to eat after games. Each player will need money for those stops.

Schedule

The current practice and game schedule is enclosed. Included are departure times from the school. Addresses of, and directions to, the schools are also included with the schedule. We are currently trying to change the Dec 5th game as it conflicts with the band concert. As that and other changes occur, an updated schedule will be placed on Trinity's website.

Practices

Practices will be held at Dozier Smith T's warehouse in Opelika (corner of 3rd Ave and N 13th St). Both teams will practice together. In addition to the scheduled practices, we may have some voluntary shoot arounds on some weekends.

Informational Meeting

An informational meeting will be held on Monday, October 31st at 5:15 pm at the school. If your son plans to participate, please plan on attending. Payment is due at that time.

Program Goals

The goals of this basketball program are to develop basketball skills among our players, to compete as a team at the highest level possible, and to win or lose with class. Each player is expected to participate in all practices and games to the best of his ability.
